DENNY REAGAN

President and Chief Executive Officer

Before being named President of The Muny in 1991, Reagan had advanced through the ranks of the “oldest and largest outdoor musical theatre in America” by working as a member of the clean-up team, runner, wardrobe dresser, stage crew, office clerk, office manager, manager of theatre operations and assistant general manager.

The Muny celebrated its landmark 100th summer season in 2018, which was also Reagan’s 50th year with the 11,000-seat outdoor theatre.

In addition to his work as head of The Muny, Denny is actively involved with a number of local and national arts, civic and academic institutions. He is a member and past-President of the National Alliance for Musical Theatre and serves on the boards of Great Circle and Central Institute for the Deaf. Denny also completed 10 years of service as a commissioner for the Regional Arts Commission.

Reagan is the recipient of numerous leadership and service awards, and in 2018 was recognized by the Arts & Education Council of Greater St. Louis for Lifetime Achievement in the Arts.
